Notes:

- 1. Graduates of the base Forestry Program during the initial year of the accreditation period may, or may not, have received accreditation-required instruction in forest entomology, forest pathology, forest harvesting, wood science and utilization. Graduates from the Program major were required to take these subjects and do not need to have a review. FPRC (Formerly CFPFA) member agencies were advised and will need to review the credentials of applicants from the base program in the initial years to determine if these subjects have been taken.
- 2. Graduates of the Forest Business Management Program (only a few students) may have elected to not take the program's capstone Integrated Forest Management instruction. FPRC (formerly CFPFA) member agencies have been alerted to this. For accreditation purposes, review teams should review the program to ensure that it provides content to meet all the Accreditation Standards.



- 3. The undergraduate Forestry program at the University of Toronto (U of T) was terminated at about this time. There is no undergraduate Forestry program at U of T since that time.
- 4. The base Forest Engineering Program was deemed to have inadequate instruction in forest ecology, forest entomology, forest pathology, forest fire management and tree physiology in relation to accreditation standards. As a result, graduates from the base program should be deemed to have not graduated from an accredited program or these gaps should be checked. The program, including the R.P.F. option, was terminated at the end of the 2012/13 academic year. The other programs were fully accredited.
